

Combination Edits Overview

Combination Editing is a feature in Cardinal that helps to maintain data integrity across all modules. Defined combinations of ChartField values are established and used to check journal entry lines in General Ledger and the other Cardinal modules.

The three components of the Combination Edits are:

1. **Combination Definition:** defines the ChartFields that are required or optional in the combination edit. For example, a Combination Definition may require an Account and a FIPS code be defined on each Journal Line.
2. **Combination Rule:** defines the valid values of the ChartFields that are named in the Combination Definition. In other words, the Combination Rule defines the specific values of each ChartField that will or will not pass the editing process for a Combination Definition.
3. **Combination Group:** links the Combination Rules that are to be applied as a group during the edit process. All rules within a group must have the same Combination Definition. ChartField combination editing compares the values entered in Cardinal to the Combination Definitions and Combination Rules that are defined.

Typically, the Combination Edits are set up under the Set ID of "STATE". However, some combination edits are set up specifically for Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT). These are all established under the Set ID of "50100".

There are two tools that can be used to review the Combination Rules and help identify the cause of a Combination Edit Error.

These tools are the **Review Combination Data** page and the **ChartField Combination Editing Rule Report**.

Navigation Note: Please note that there may be a **Notify** button at the bottom of various pages utilized while completing the processes within this Job Aid. This "Notify" functionality is not currently turned on to send email notifications to specific users within Cardinal.

When users receive a Combination Edit Error on a transaction, the error is identified by Combination Group. Users can use the Combination Group to identify the associated Combination Rule.

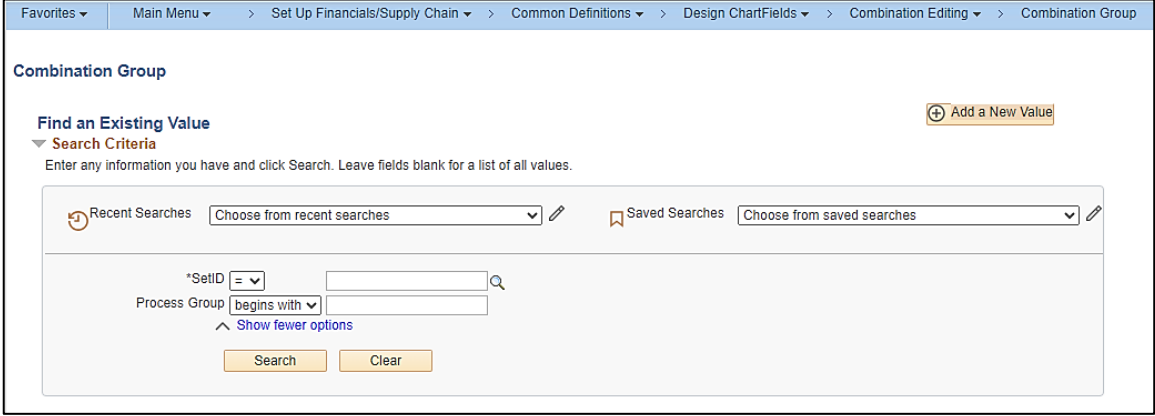

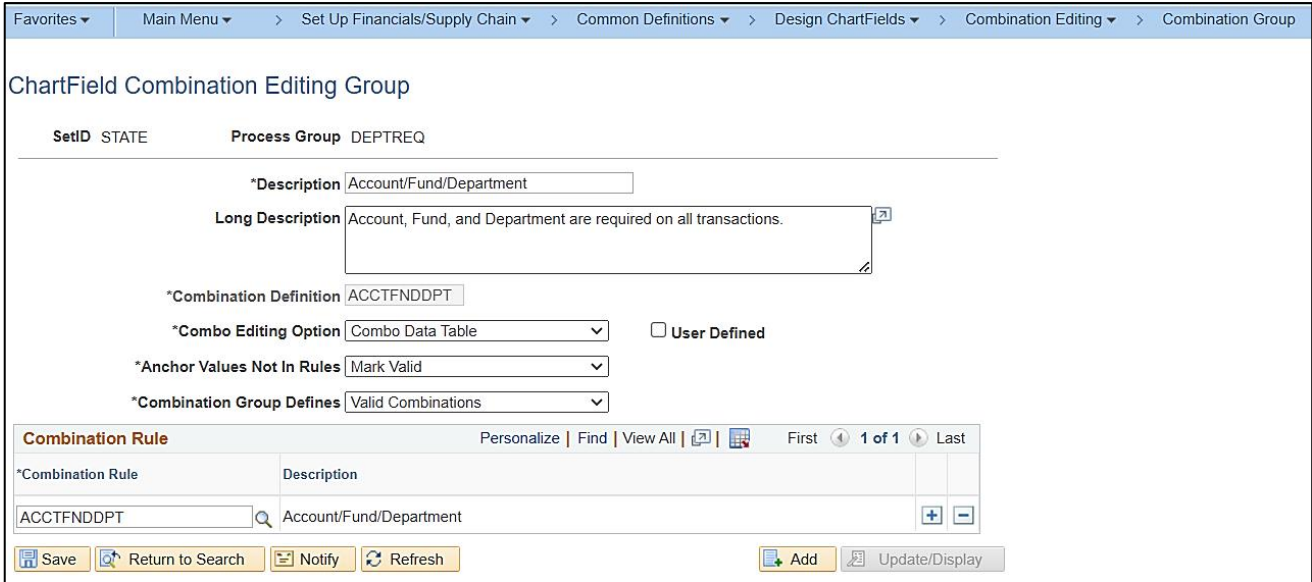

All of the associated Combination Rules are listed in the **Combination Rule** section. If there is more than one rule associated, the user may be able to narrow down the choices based upon the text that is found within the error message. In this example, the error relates to the Account/Fund/Department (i.e., Combination Rule “ACCTFNDDPT”).

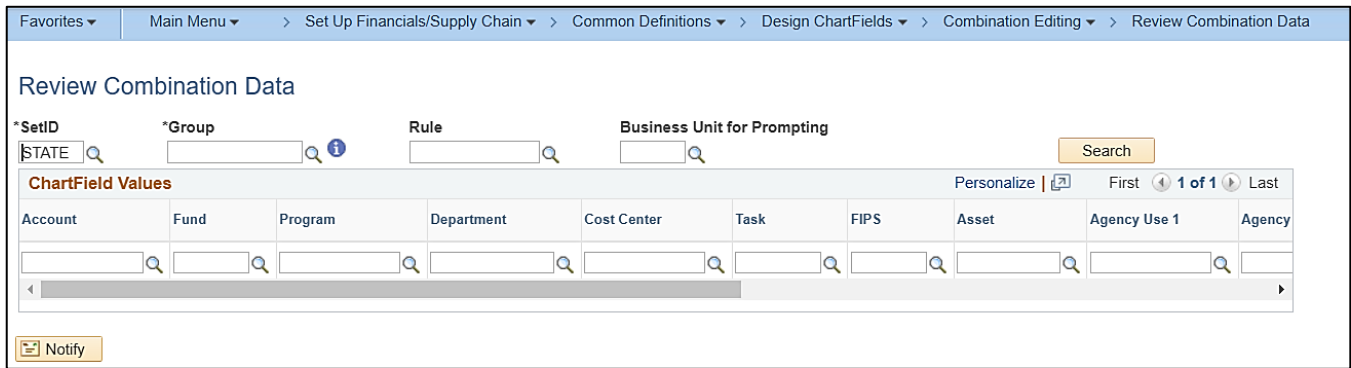

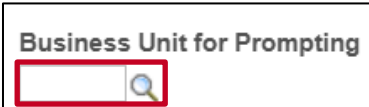
Overview of the Review Combination Data Page

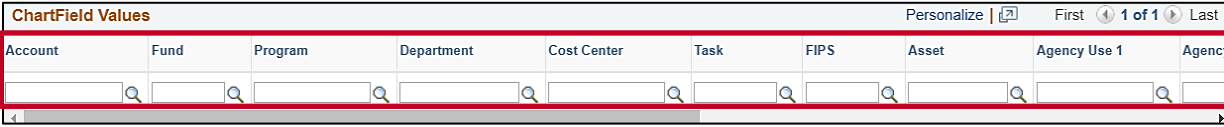

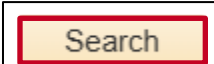
This page is used to retrieve data relating to valid ChartField combinations that have been entered and built in the system during Cardinal's overnight batch processing. If a new combination is created, it will not appear in this inquiry until after the build process is run overnight in Cardinal.

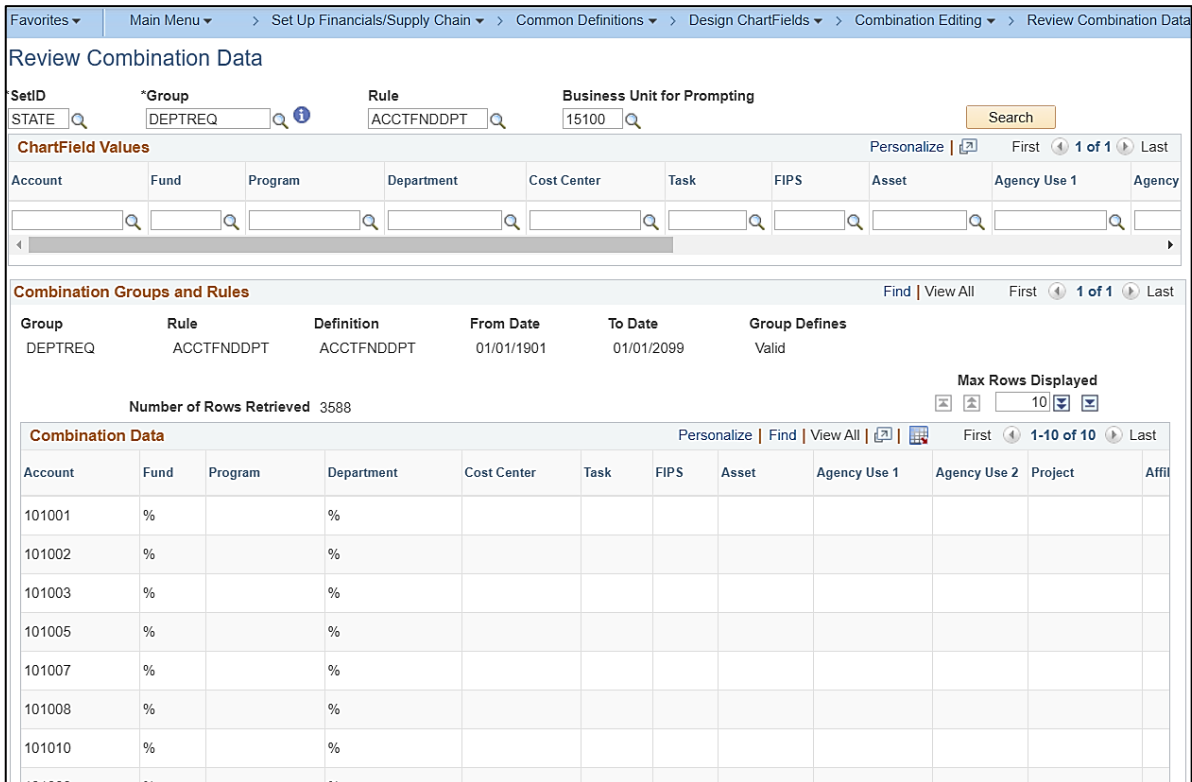
